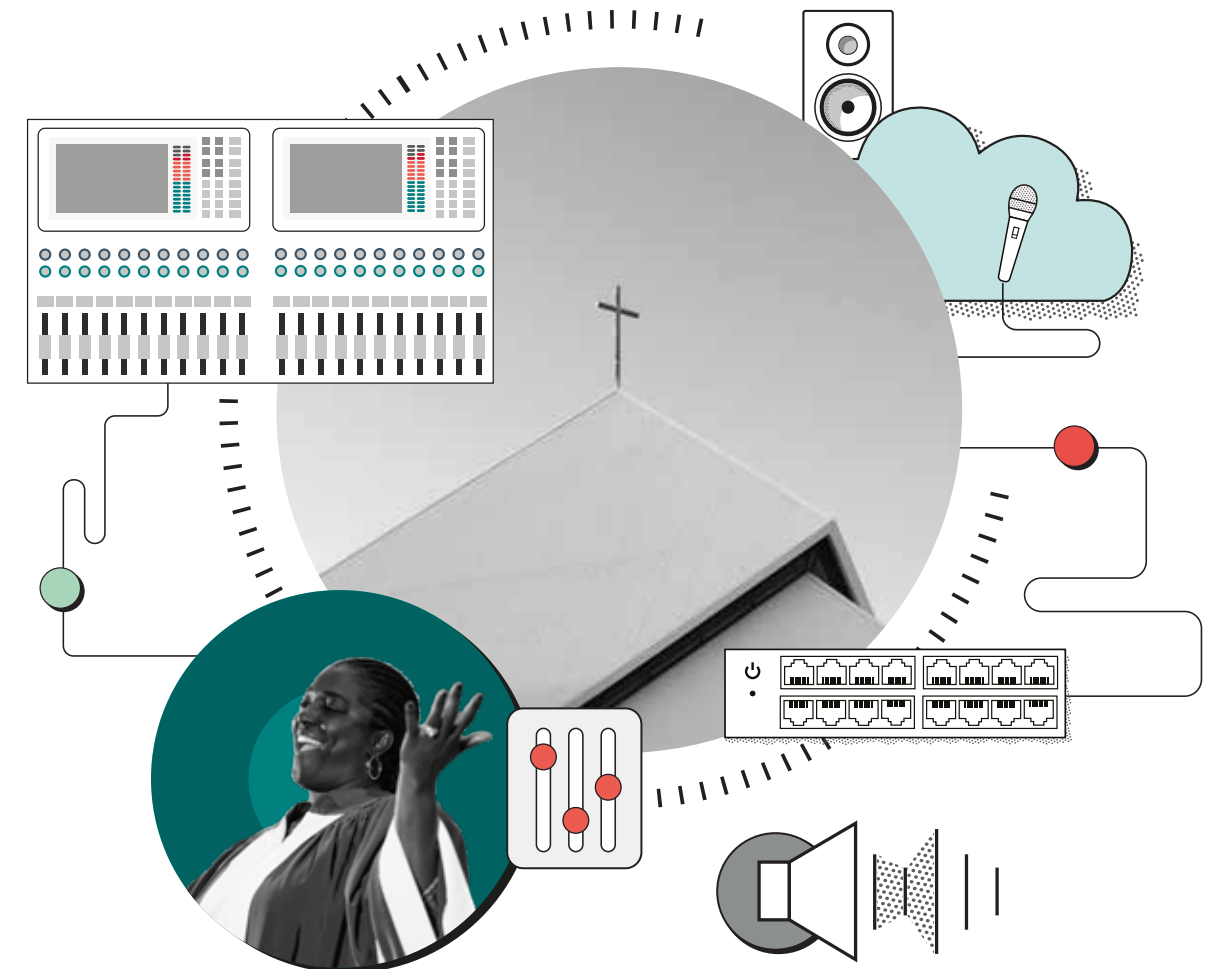
Application Diagram

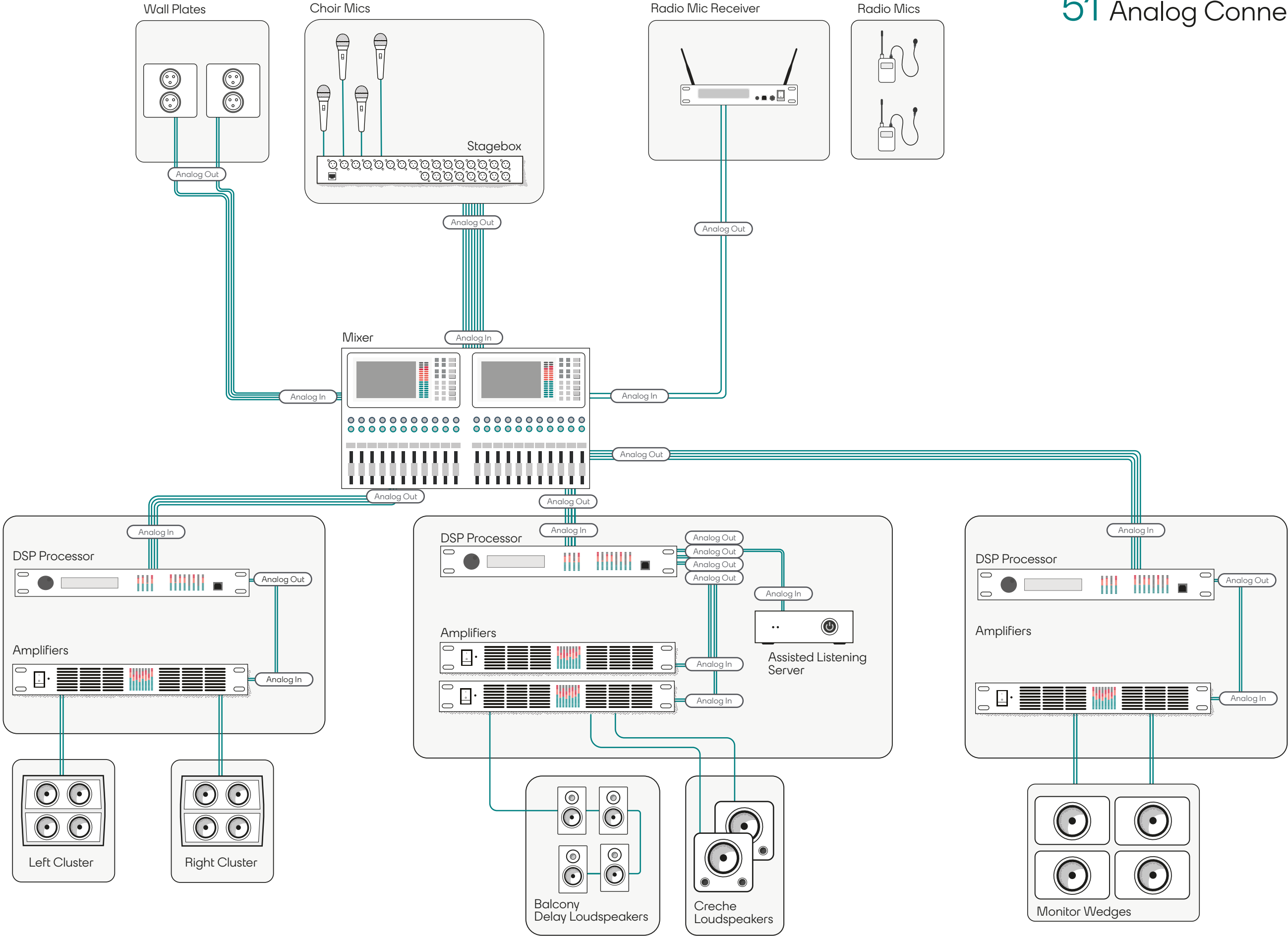
